Holiday Recycling Tip

With the holiday approaching, remember wrapping paper, tissue paper, holiday cards and envelopes, gift boxes, shipping boxes are all recyclable. Please place all these items in your blue recycling cart; or you can take your extra recycling to the Township DPW Yard on Mon - Fri 7am to 2 pm and every third Saturday of the month from 8am to 1pm.

Foil wrapping paper is not recyclable.

The Pinelands Branch Library will be moving from their current location at 39 Allen Avenue on December 7th. The Pinelands Library will re-open to the public at their new location on the 1st Floor of the Medford Towns Hall building located at 49 Union Street on Monday, December 13, 2021.



ANNUAL FALL LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

The 2021 Fall Leaf Collection program, which began the week of October 25th, is on-going.

Crews have completed leaf collection in Zones 1 and 2. At this time, no additional collections have been scheduled for these Zones. In the event another collection is scheduled, updates will be posted on the Township website and Facebook page, as well as through Nixle alert.

As of the week of November 29th, crews are currently working in Zone 3 and will continue working in this Zone until all leaves are collected. Leaves should have been placed at the street by Monday morning to ensure collection. Each street is collected once. The remaining Zones will be collected according to the schedule below:

Zone 5: Week of December 6th - **delays are expected

Zone 4: Week of December 13th - **delays are expected

Winter weather may further delay leaf collection if a snowfall is experienced during leaf collection time lines.

Residents with leaves to dispose of outside of the annual Fall Collection program may bring them to the DPW Yard on Gravelly Hollow Road. Residents who place leaves at the street for collection outside of the Township's Collection Program could be cited for violation of Township Ordinance.

Any leaves placed at the street by professional landscapers, contractors, or anyone hired by a homeowner, must be removed by them.
