#### **NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING & LIBRARY**

The Library is expected to relocate later this year.

#### MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY/TOWNSHIP OFFICE HOURS

The Township Offices, including the Township DPW Yard, will be closed on Monday, May 31st in observance of Memorial Day.

### **PRIMARY ELECTION DAY**

Primary Election Day is Tuesday, June 8, 2021. Polls will be open from 6:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. Voters may also vote by mail or drop their ballot in any Ballot Box within Burlington County. Medford Township has a ballot box located at the new Town Hall, 49 Union Street, Medford. The box is located on the right side of the building (see picture below).

#### MONTHLY RECYCLING TIP

Used syringes are a common contaminant at the Burlington County Recycling Center, and also a dangerous one that puts the safety of their workers at risk! Therefore, they do not belong in your recycling container.

### \*\*Never place them in your recycling\*\*

To safely dispose of used syringes, place the clipped needle and syringe in a sturdy plastic container such as a detergent bottle. Put a warning label stating "WARNING: USED SYRING-ES" on the container. Seal the bottle and tightly recap it, as well as duct tape it to secure the lid.

To correctly and safely dispose of the container, please bring it to a participating hospital or place it in your regular trash. **DO NOT RECYCLE THIS CONTAINER.**

Kirby's Mill will be open with the water wheel in operation grinding cornmeal, the smithy will be working the forge in the Blacksmith Shop and the Farm Museum in the Barn will also be opening for viewing. On the grounds, our collection of wagons and buggies can be found in the Carriage House. Historic crafters will be plying their crafts along with other demonstrations. The big wheel lathe in the Cabinets Makers Shop, on the second floor, will be turning. Young visitors can take a turn at a hands on experience turning the big wheel and working the mortising machine in the Car-

penter's Shop. Any member who would like to demonstrate their hobby craft please contact John Hines at 609-531-1825. We also need volunteers to assist with visitors and help with demonstration of various items on display at Kirby's Mill. Masks are required inside all of our buildings. Admission is free.
