General Election Day: Voting Locations for November 6, 2018. Polls are open from 6:00 am – 8:00 pm.

Districts 1, 2 and 6 will no longer vote at the Public Safety Building District 8 will no longer vote at Haines School District 17 will no longer vote at Bob Bende Park Building

November 11th at 11:00 AM – **Veterans Day Observance** at the Main Street Memorials (Next to the Community Center) sponsored by Medford Township and the Medford VFW Post 7677.

November 17th at 11:00 AM – **Dedication Ceremony for Still Park (**formerly known as Cranberry Park). The Park is located at 44 Charles Street, (behind the Cranberry Hall Senior Center & Municipal Building on North Main Street). On February 2, 2016 the Township Council approved a Resolution authorizing the renaming of "Cranberry Park" to "Still Park" in honor of the accomplishments and historical legacy of Dr. James Still, the "Black Doctor of the Pines". The idea to recognize the important historical impact of Dr. James Still's contributions to the community of Medford was initially presented by the Oversight Committee of the Dr. James Still Historic Site and Education Center and the Medford Historical Society.

Medford Township utilized \$78,000 in Federal Community Development Block Grant Program administered by Burlington County to complete handicapped accessibility improvements in Still Park, including new accessible curb cuts on Church, Filbert and Mulberry Streets and new sidewalks and other enhancements throughout the Park. The Township Council also allocated fund to build a base for a new memorial acknowledging Dr. Still that is being donated by the Oversight Committee.

The Dr. James Still Historic Office and Education Center will also host an open house after the ceremony from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM at their facility located at 211 Church Road in Medford.

RECYCLING TIPS OF THE MONTH

Residents are reminded NO Plastic Bags are to be in the Carts -

Keep plastic bags out of recycling buckets and carts. Plastic bags cause big trouble for single stream recycling systems. They get tangled in the sorting screens. Recycle plastic bags at supermarkets or stores such as Loews, Home Depot, Target, etc. Burlington County Park Rangers will accept clean dry plastic bags for reuse at the park's waste stations.

Caps on Water Bottles --

The caps should stay on the empty water bottles so they don't flatten before they can be sorted correctly. When they are not capped they crush flat and go out on the paper line. The caps keep the air trapped in the bottles and help retain shape.
