Annual Fall Leaf Collection Program

The 2019 Leaf Collection program began the week of October 28th. The schedule is as follows:

ZONE 3: Weeks of October 28th and November 25th

ZONE 1: Weeks of November 4th and December 2nd

ZONE 2: Weeks of November 4th and December 2nd

ZONE 5: Weeks of November 11th and December 9th

ZONE 4: Weeks of November 18th and December 16th



Residents with leaves to dispose of outside of the annual Fall Collection program may bring them to the DPW Yard on Gravelly Hollow Road. All leaves should be removed from the curbside and disposed of by other means until official notice of the Leaf program is released by the Township. Residents who place leaves at the street for collection outside of the Township's Collection program could be cited for violation of Township Ordinance.

HOT PATCH MACHINE

Recently, the Township purchased a hot patch machine through Milspray in order to more efficiently repair municipal roadways. The Dragon Asphalt Mixer gives the Township's Road Division staff in the Department of Neighborhood Services the ability to produce hot asphalt year-round using asphalt millings. It eliminates the need for trips to the asphalt plant or use of a hot box. The Asphalt Mixer can produce virgin Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), from millings on-site, in under 10 minutes. The hot asphalt provides a longer lasting patch on roads than using traditional cold patch. The machine is towed behind a small dump truck and carries excess millings to make the patch as needed. The machine has been in use for several weeks and produces a quality asphalt repair.
