PARK RESTROOMS TO BE RE-OPENED

Beginning on September 9, 2019, the restroom facilities at Freedom Park, Medford Park and Bob Meyer Park will be open to the public from 8:00 am to dusk. The restroom facilities had once been an area frequented by vandalism and there were challenges with locking the facilities in the evening. The Township Council authorized funding in the 2019 Capital Budget for locks and cameras for the buildings so the facilities could be re-opened to the public.

BUNNING FIELD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Township will be accepting bids later this month to refurbish Bunning Field in Medford Park. Medford was awarded a \$200,000 grant under the Burlington County Municipal Park Development Grant program to undertake renovations and upgrades to this historic baseball field, located on Mill Street. Bunning Field has a long and storied history in Medford, beginning with its construction by residents (along with Medford Park) in the early 1900's. It is reported that baseball players such as Cy Young played there back in the 1930's and 1940's on semipro adult baseball teams. More recently, MLB All-Star Mike Trout played there as a teen with a South Jersey stars travel team in the early 2000s. The original grandstands shown in the photo are estimated to have been built early in the 1900's. Regrettably, the grandstands had to be torn down due to deterioration of the wood, but given their history, they will be re-built to maintain their 1900's architectural and historical style, but will be constructed in accordance with current construction and handicapped accessibility

In 2015 the Township Council approved an agreement with the Medford Vincentown Rotary Club to help restore the grandstands and the surrounding Medford Park. The Rotary Club is committed to partnering with Township officials on this project.
