BRUSH COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Township officials announced last month that Brush will be collected on a monthly basis. This trial program will run for six months through December, 2023.

The collection program will follow the monthly schedule below:

<u>July, 2023:</u>

Week of 7/3 – Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 7/10 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 7/17 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 7/24 – Zone 5 will be collected Week of 7/31 – crews will complete any areas that may have been delayed

August, 2023:

Week of 8/7 – Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 8/14 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 8/21 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 8/28 – Zone 5 will be collected

September, 2023:

Week of 9/4 – Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 9/11 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 9/18 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 9/25 – Zone 5 will be collected

October, 2023:

Week of 10/2– Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 10/9 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 10/16 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 10/23 – Zone 5 will be collected Week of 10/30 – crews will complete any areas that may have been delayed

November, 2023:

Week of 11/6 – Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 11/13 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 11/20 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 11/27 – Zone 5 will be collected

December, 2023:

Week of 12/4 – Zones 1 and 2 will be collected Week of 12/11 – Zone 3 will be collected Week of 12/18 – Zone 4 will be collected Week of 12/25 – Zone 5 will be collected

January, 2024:

No collections will be made in January as the program will be evaluated for continued implementation

Requirements for brush collection will remain the same. All brush must be placed at the street no earlier than ten (10) days before a scheduled collection. In the fall months, brush and leaves must be separated. Brush must be at the street by 6 am on the Monday of the scheduled collection week. Each street will be collected once.

IMPORTANT UPDATE ON 2023/2024 TAX BILLS

As of July 31st, the Township just received and confirmed the final 2023 Tax Rate from Burlington County in order to print and mail the 2023/2024 Tax Bills. It will take approximately two (2) weeks to print and mail the bills. An extended grace period will be provided until close of business on <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 8th</u> to pay the 3rd quarter tax bill. (by State law this is 25 calendar days from the date they are mailed). The mailing date and due date information will also be noted on the tax bills, posted on the News Feed on the website, and also posted on the Township's official Facebook page.

Pre-scheduled ACH payments will be deducted on Thursday, August 24th.



NATIONAL TOURING ARTIST LOW CUT CONNIE TO HEADLINE MEDFORD OKTOBERFEST & MUSIC FESTIVAL IN FREEDOM PARK ON SEPTEMBER 15-16th

The Medford Business Association (MBA) announced that the annual Medford Oktoberfest & Music Festival will be held on **Friday September 15, 2023 from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. and Saturday September 16, 2023 from 1:00 to 9:00 p.m.** at Freedom Park, 86 Union Street. Considered "Medford's Biggest Party of the Year," the event is organized and promoted by the Medford Business Association, with ShopRite of Medford as its

Presenting Sponsor. Parking & admission are free, and the event is open to all ages.

This year's event will feature a massive beer tent, sponsored by Taunton Forge Liquors, that will serve not only well-known national and international brands and Oktoberfest brews, but also local crafts from area brewers. Plenty of food trucks will be on site offering a variety of options, as well as a vendor offering traditional German food favorites.

The event will feature over 20 musical artists on two stages. Friday night's main stage lineup includes a full set from nationaltouring artist **Low Cut Connie** in support of the band's highly anticipated new album, *Art Dealers*. Joining Low Cut Connie on the Friday night main stage will be the Katie Henry Band and Velvet Rouge. Music starts at 5:15 p.m. with Low Cut Connie hitting the stage around 7:30 p.m.

Popular country rock artist **Kenny Curcio**, who grew up in Medford and now splits his time between New Jersey and Nashville, will headline Saturday's main stage lineup. Kenny's newest single, *Jersey Shore*, quickly became a summer anthem when it was released in June. Kenny will be making his second appearance at Oktoberfest, but the first with his Nashville-based band. Saturday's main stage will also include performances by Kyle Sparkman, Groove Merchants, Calista Garcia, The Vaughns, and a closing set from Oktoberfest-favorites My Funky Brethren, making their third appearance at the festival.

Both days will feature a second music stage located in one of Freedom Park's large open-air gazebos. On Friday night, the Gazebo Stage lineup opens with groove band The Triple T's, followed by pop artists Sun Psychic, before turning it over to local up-and-coming bands Sunrise Cries and Wasted Potential.

Saturday's Gazebo Stage lineup opens with a classic rock cover set from The Loan Rangers, followed by singer-songwriters The Gender Gnomes, Ian Miller, and Ryan Jesse. As the sun starts to fade, some of the region's favorite bands take over – Only on Weekends, All Systems Go, Out of Service, and Brian Quirk.

This year's event will also feature three heats of a Bavarian Stein-holding competition, sponsored by King's Road Brewing Co., with judges from the United States Steinholding Association. One heat will be held on Friday and two on Saturday, with the winners of each heat advancing to the NJ State Finals on October 21 at the Feed Mill in Medford. Interested participants can sign up in person at the event while spots last.

Saturday will also feature a business fair with scores of local businesses, crafters, artisans, and more.

Children of all ages are welcome to attend both days, and there will be special activities just for them on Saturday.

Free parking is available at Freedom Park and surrounding areas. In addition, shuttle buses will run from Sharps Run Plaza parking lot on Route 70 and Medford Village.
