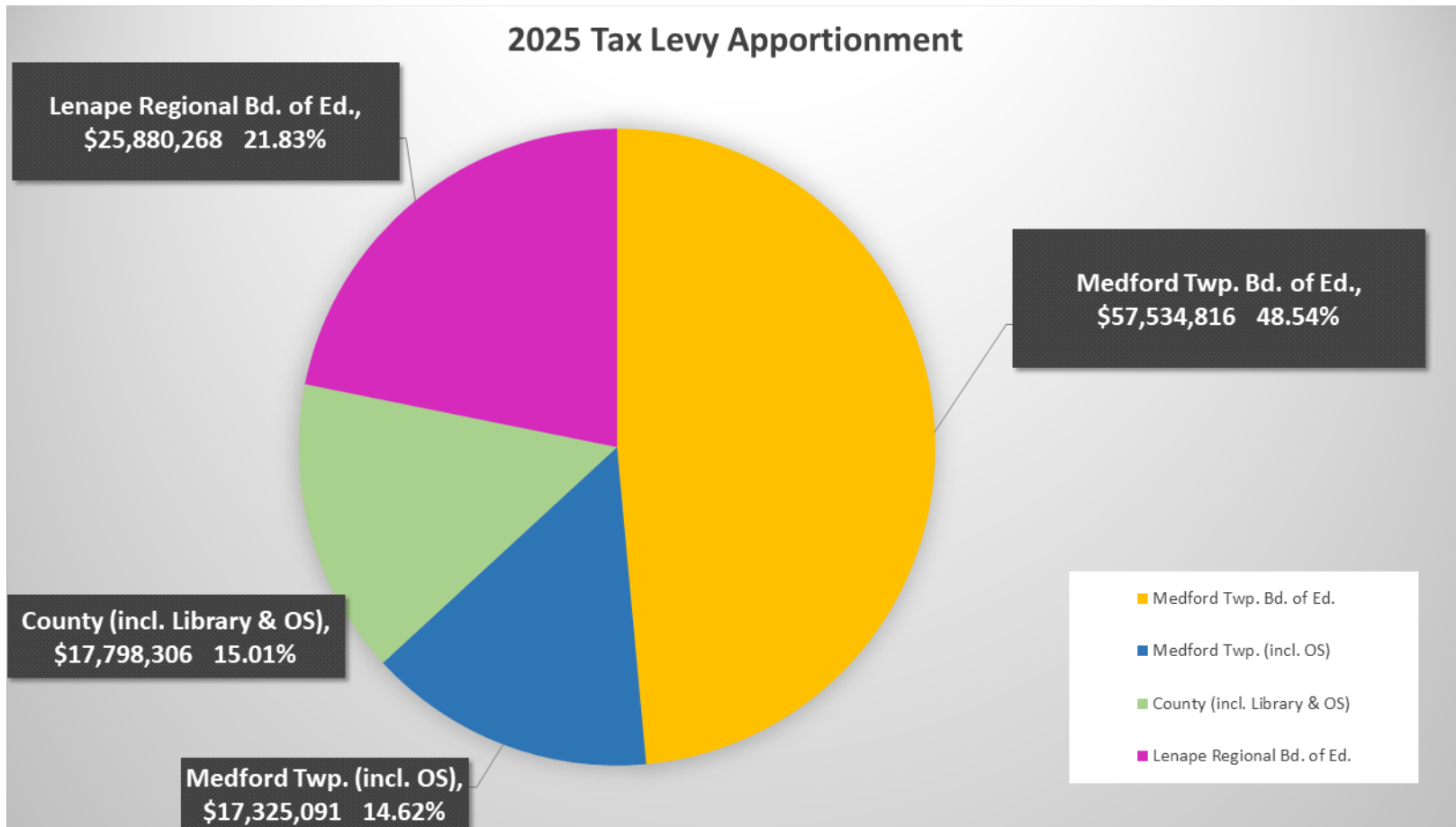


Dear Medford Resident, the chart below depicts how your Tax bill is apportioned among the four taxing agencies. Of these, Medford Township's share is the **lowest at 14.62%**, including the Open Space tax. The Township's portion pays for vital services for you and your family, including Police, Fire and EMS, as well as Township parks, trails and open spaces, Public Works (roads, buildings, public works center), Trash Collection, our *thriving* Community Events and the cost of running Town Hall (Tax assessment and collection, Finance, Clerk, Manager, etc.).



The 2025 annual tax bill for a home assessed at the Township average (\$331,656) is \$12,450.36.

This amount is distributed among the taxing agencies as follows:

Medford Board of Education: \$6,042.77

Lenape Regional: \$2,719.58

Burlington County: \$1,867.22

Medford Township: \$1,820.79

Medford Township's share of the 2025 annual tax bill for a home assessed at the Township average (\$331,656) is **\$1,820.79**.

Here are the services your tax dollars fund (by function):

Police Department (18%): \$327.74

Capital Improvements (roads, buildings, parks, etc.) and debt service (14%): \$254.91

Insurance (liability, healthcare, workers compensation, etc.) (13%): \$236.70

Trash Collection, recycling and brush disposal (12%): \$218.50

Statutory expenses (employer payroll taxes/FICA and pensions) (10%): \$182.08

Fire & Emergency Medical Services (7.0%): \$127.46

Public Works – streets & roads, buildings & grounds, etc. (5.0%): \$91.04

Reserve for Uncollected Taxes (5.0%): \$91.04

Utilities (Natural Gas, Electric, Street lights, etc.) (4.0%): \$72.83

Township Administration (Assessor, Collector, Clerk, Manager, Finance) (3.0%): \$54.62

Planning, Zoning and Code Enforcement (3.0%): \$54.62

Miscellaneous Expenses (6.0%): \$109.25
