Dear Medford Water Customer:

The Township of Medford's Utility Department is implementing a Water Meter Replacement Program to replace aging meters and ensure continued accuracy for customer billing purposes. The new meters will continue to be read automatically, which provides a more efficient method to collect water usage data.

Your cooperation will be needed to implement this program. The Township of Medford has engaged LENEGAN Plumbing & Heating, LLC to manage the Water Meter Replacement Program and to perform the meter replacement work.

There is no cost to you for the meter.

Access into your residence will be necessary for the replacement work, so appointments for the meter installations will be required. It is important that you call the telephone number listed below to set up your appointment as soon as possible. Or, if more convenient, you may schedule your appointment on LENEGAN's website also listed below. Appointments are available Monday through Friday 8 AM to 6 PM.

It is mandatory that all Medford Water customers have their meter replaced.

It is expected the replacement work will require approximately 15-20 minutes. The installers from LENEGAN Plumbing and Heating, LLC will have personal identification badges that are issued by The Township of Medford. Please make sure your water meter is accessible prior to the scheduled installation date. In addition, please ensure that your isolation valve(s) is operational. These valves (on either side of the meter) are considered as part of the home's plumbing and are the homeowner's responsibility.
